

# BISHOP ROAD UPDATE

This correspondence serves as an update on the recent activity to address the landfill fire in the City of South Fulton located at 7635 Bishop Road.

City of South Fulton officials met Thursday, January 31, 2019 with South Fulton House Delegation Representatives Debra Bazemore, Roger Bruce and Sharon Beasley Teague, the Georgia Dept. of Natural Resources, Georgia Environmental Protection Division and the Georgia Attorney General's Office to further discuss emergency abatement efforts at the landfill.

Enforcement actions, to date against the landfill's owner, Tandy Bullock have not been successful in eliminating the burning at the landfill. These actions include Mr. Bullock's incarceration, and his attempts to extinguish the fire, administrative proceedings, as well as pending criminal and contempt actions before the Fulton County Superior Court and South Fulton Municipal Court.

The above governmental agencies that met yesterday developed an action plan which should help to substantially reduce or eliminate the fire and smoke emitting from the landfill in the near future. Aggressive enforcement action by the involved agencies against Mr. Bullock will simultaneously continue while the action plan is underway.

The matter is scheduled for a Motions Calendar in the Municipal Court of South Fulton on **Wednesday, February 13, 2019 at 1:30 pm. Court will be held in the Union City Courthouse at 5060 Union St., Union City, GA.**
